



# EHRLO HOUSING

Part of Ranch Ehrlo Society's community services, Ehrlo Housing provides affordable housing to low-income families, youth, adults with chronic mental health conditions, and young people transitioning from care.

Since 1997, Ehrlo Housing has been a trusted provider of quality, affordable housing in Regina. The program currently manages 90 units and three commercial spaces across the city.

Through strong partnerships with organizations such as the Phoenix Residential Society, John Howard Society, Y-Shore, the City of Regina, the Saskatchewan Housing Corporation, and the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation, Ehrlo Housing continues to make a positive impact in the community.



## AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR FAMILIES



### Lakeshore Village

- 43 affordable apartment units (1- and 2-bedroom) designed for families, featuring an on-site housing & support office and the Creative Corners Daycare Cooperative.
- Ehrlo Housing has owned, renovated, and professionally managed the property since 1997, providing safe and welcoming homes for tenants.

### Project revitalization

- Plans are currently underway to begin upgrading infrastructure and health and safety repairs.

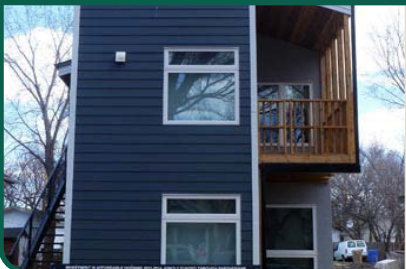
## AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR SINGLES



### McEwen Manor

- 39 affordable studio rental units, plus one support services unit for single adults participating in the Phoenix Residential Society treatment program.
- Ehrlo Housing has owned and professionally managed the property since 2011, with funding secured through municipal, provincial, and federal grants and loans.
- Ehrlo Housing led the construction of the building and continues to provide long-term oversight.
- The property operates in an arms-length partnership with Phoenix Residential Society, which delivers on-site support and programming to tenants.

## AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR YOUTH



### CHAZ Court

- Eight affordable 200 sq. ft. studio suites for young, single adults.
- Capital funding provided through the Saskatchewan Housing Corporation Rental Development Program, with additional support from the City of Regina's Social Development Reserve.
- Ehrlo Housing has owned and professionally managed the property since 2014.
