

The Family Centred Addiction Program is an innovative addictions treatment centre that provides intensive supports for parents experiencing substance misuse while maintaining the family structure.

It's about keeping families together

The Family Centred Addiction Program builds on the work created by the Family Treatment Program of keeping families together and healthy while offering families an intensive addiction component.

Individuals seeking treatment for addictions recovery and relapse prevention will attend daily structured holistic programming focusing on trauma, mental health, co-dependency, family function, and addictions psychological education.

Weekly programming will also be offered to children and youth impacted by parental addictions.

Highly trained staff will provide daily support in the family home to assist in relationship building, parenting skills, and overall positive family functioning.

Core program components

- 24/7 on-site staff in a secured apartment building which can host up to eight families.
- Based in Moose Jaw, SK.
- Each family resides in own two or three bedroom apartment; with all basic needs met (groceries, housing supplies, furniture).
- Mental health and addiction counsellor, clinicians and a highly trained staff team on site.
- Parents receive individual and in person mental health and addictions counselling including recovery plans and goals.
- Group programming using evidence based curriculum is available Monday-Friday.
- Direct in home supports are provided by treatment staff on an intensive basis.
- Once the family has stabilized, less intensive services will be recommended for referral for long-term family support.



Referrals are made by the provincial and/or territorial Ministries of Social Services/ Health, First Nation agencies, and other referral agencies that provide cost coverage for treatment.
